Mental Healthcare (MGICMH) is a comprehensive mental healthcare unit based in Kothapet, Guntur town in Andhra Pradesh. The team comprises of a psychologist, occupational therapist, mental health nurses, psychiatric social worker and care assistants. This unit was inaugurated as a first of its kind based in a community with a specific rehab focus on chronic mental illness and substance misuse on 14th Feb 2010. This organisation is a NGO which runs on a **not-for profit** basis under the umbrella of **Empower Trust, Guntur**. Empower is a registered charitable trust based in Guntur aiming to provide comprehensive mental healthcare affordable to all the sections of population in the community. The project intends to provide treatment, training and research facilities in mental health sector. Hamlet GIP Trust has offered to support the unit by way of sending staff to MGICMH to provide training. The aim of this project is to create a comprehensive and affordable healthcare to all social and economic sections of the population in Guntur.
